- Participate in a science Lab in 5th and 6th grades.

Pre- Kindergarten students must be able to:

- Take care of own bodily functions (i.e. bathroom, nose, etc.).
- Have age appropriate communication skills.
- Separate from parent without disturbing classroom after the first few weeks of school.
- Feed himself/herself.
- Maintain age appropriate social skills.
- Sit still for a period of 15 minutes.
