- Focus on tasks for a period ranging from 55 minutes to 110 minutes with a break.

- Communicate in English at a grade appropriate level.
- Contribute verbally to class discussion in a way that is not disruptive.
- Maintain proficiency level in all coursework.
- Maintain an age appropriate grade placement level.
- Read books and perform mathematic calculations at a grade appropriate level.
- Communicate in writing at a grade appropriate level.
- Operate a calculator (beginning at grade 7).
- Participate in Science Lab activities.

Grammar School student requirements:

- Arrive in designated classroom at the appropriate time prepared for class to begin.
- Carry or pull a backpack (books, paper, etc.) of a weight ranging from 10-25 lbs. to and from school and between classes.
- Focus on a task for a period ranging from 15-30 minutes for Kindergarten through 2nd and 20-45 minutes for 3rd through 6th grades.
- Sit for a period of 20 minutes for Kindergarten through 2nd grade and 30-40 minutes for 3rd through 6th grades.
- Contribute verbally to class discussions in a way that is not disruptive.
- Maintain an age appropriate grade placement level.
- Perform mathematic calculations at a grade appropriate level.
- Communicate in writing at a grade appropriate level.
- Participate in a science Lab in 5th and 6th grades.

Pre- Kindergarten student requirements:

- Take care of own bodily functions (i.e. bathroom, nose, etc.).
- Have age appropriate communication skills.
- Separate from parent without disturbing classroom after the first few weeks of school.
- Feed himself/herself.
- Maintain age appropriate social skills.
- Sit still for a period of 15 minutes.
