General Supplies required per family

- ___ 6 qty CPP BLUE pocket folders with clasps (inexpensive paper folders are fine and are only approx. 40 cents each online with Walmart)
- ___ 3 Chisel-tip Expo dry erase markers (markers only)
- ___ 1 package construction paper, assorted colors
- ___ 1 White-out Correction Tape

General supplies required per student

(Please do not write your child's name on General Supplies.)

- ___ 4 reams of white copy paper
- ___ 1 black Sharpie permanent marker

- ___ Scissors (age appropriate)
- ___ 3 qty glue sticks
- ___ eraser tips
- ___ colored pencils (8 count)
- ___ Pocket dictionary / thesaurus
- ___ Thin line washable markers (8 count)

- ___ Loose-leaf wide-ruled notebook paper (150 count)
- ___ 12" ruler with inches, centimeters, and '0' mark
- ___ 3-hole punch recommended for the home, but not required
- ___ 8 qty 3-ring tabbed dividers with pockets for Taxi
- ___ 1.5" 3-ring BLUE pocket view binder for Taxi
- ___ 1" binder for history notebook
- ___ 3"X5" lined index cards (100 count) for Latin/Greek roots and vocal)
