2. How does Goff's approach to love challenge conventional perceptions of love and action?

5. Discuss the significance of the title *Love Does*. What implication does it have on understanding the book's message?
6. What role does courage play in the stories and lessons shared in *Love Does*?
7. Evaluate the impact of Goff's personal anecdotes on the reader's understanding of living a life of love and purpose.
8. How does *Love Does* address the concept of failure, and what lesson does Goff draw from it?
9. In what ways does Goff encourage readers to engage with their communities, and what impact does he suggest this will have?
10. Analyze the role of whimsy in *Love Does*. How does Goff use it to convey deeper truths about life and love?
